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Terms & Conditions

1. Fox Meadow Light & Sound ("The Company") agrees to supply and, if included in the contract, install and/or operate, equipment ("The Equipment") for the agreed duration of hire.
2. The Company shall have free and unhindered access to The Equipment at all reasonable times whilst it remains on the premises being used by The Customer.
3. The Customer is liable for any damage, loss or theft of The Equipment, howsoever caused, from the time it arrives on the premises (or collected by The Customer from our warehouse) until the time it is collected by The Company (or is returned by The Customer to our warehouse), unless such damage is the result of normal wear and tear.
4. The Customer must satisfy him/her self that the installation made by The Company is satisfactory and safe for the purposes intended, and that The Equipment supplied is suitable for the purposes of The Customer.
5. The Customer must ensure The Equipment remains in safe condition, with all safety cables and other features intact, at all times while The Equipment is on the premises. Any item suspected of being unsafe must not be used, and must be reported to The Company immediately. The Customer must take all reasonable steps necessary to ensure no damage or injury can result from said equipment.
6. The Customer will indemnify The Company from all responsibility of claims in respect of accident, injury or consequential damage and loss as a result of The Equipment being on the premises, howsoever caused.
7. The Company will endeavour to supply and maintain The Equipment for the agreed duration of hire, but reserves the right to alter the equipment specification should unforeseen circumstances arise.
8. The Customer must ensure that any structure or electrical circuit The Equipment is attached or connected to has appropriate safety certificates granted for it to be used for the purpose. The customer indemnifies The Company from any claims relating to the failure of such electrical supplies or failure of any structure to which it is attached, including damage to The Company's property.
9. The Customer must ensure The Equipment is not activated, operated, adjusted or moved by any person other than a member of The Company, or representatives of The Customer with specific skills to do so and approved by The Company beforehand.
10. Any equipment belonging to The Customer or any Third Party (including the owner of the premises) that is agreed may be operated in conjunction with, or controlled by, The Equipment belonging to The Company shall be the responsibility of The Customer, and The Company shall not be liable for any damage caused to it, however sustained.
11. Failure of any of The Equipment must be notified to The Company as soon as possible. If exchange or repair is required, The Company reserves the right to charge a callout fee if The Equipment failed for any reason other than normal wear and tear.
12. The Customer shall be liable for any damage caused by The Equipment being modified, altered, or used for purposes other than it's stated use, including damage from the use of any fluids not supplied by The Company for that specific equipment.
